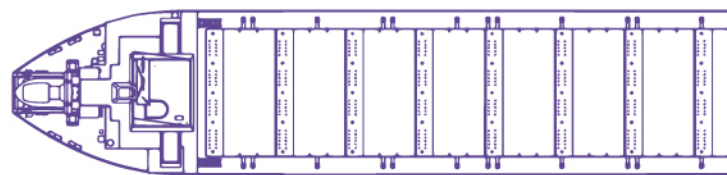
Our Mission
